Within the framework of its collections, the Museum is in possession of many tens of thousands of museum items, documents, photographs and other material.

Archeological, ethnographic, literal-historical, library, numismatic, written and other exhibits and programs in the exhibition area and Museum depots, very vividly and in a picturesque manner with continuity, have depicted and testified the condensed happenings which constantly have taken place in Herzegovina and Mostar.

The constancy and intensity of those happenings are confirmed by gone epochs, and they are kept and inherited by the Museum.

The Museum of Herzegovina is placed at the memorial house of "Džemal Bijedić", at 4 Bajatova Street. It is open to visitors and researchers for scientific and publicistic research, and as a part documentary collection, at the specified area, documentary films from the impressive film archives of the Museum.
